



FWCP 2015 REVIEW: A Survey of Perceptions and Improvement Opportunities

Overview:

The FWCP has contracted **Insights West**, based in Vancouver, to undertake an independent, third-party review to assess perceptions of the FWCP, and gather input on what is working well and potential opportunities for improvement. The results from the Review will be used to strengthen the FWCP's approach to fulfilling its vision.

The Review process is being developed with input from First Nations, public stakeholders, the Province of BC, Fisheries and Oceans Canada and BC Hydro, and will be completed in December 2015. The Review is not the Program Evaluation and Audit as outlined in the FWCP's Governance Manual.

Insights West will be using a mixed-methodology approach in September and October to ask questions about the FWCP to key three audiences: FWCP stakeholders; First Nations involved with the FWCP; and the public who are aware of the Program. There will also be a self-selecting survey, with the link being available on the FWCP website for any person wanting to provide input not contacted by Insights West.

BC Hydro is funding the Review and, as a result, there will be no reduction to FWCP project spending.
